The categories are: **NEW HANDCRAFTED ITEMS; CONSULTANTS; COLLECTIBLES; CHILDREN'S ITEMS; & INFORMATION BOOTHS.**

Please make sure you mark on your form the need for unloading a large vehicle. We are placing those vendors in a location that will allow them easy access to unload and load their supplies.

Please remember are a family first event. We strongly encourage you to reflect on that when you display your merchandise or informational materials.

Also, we are having a special theme this year, a **PATRIOTIC HERITAGE DAY!** This is to celebrate **AMERICA 250.** So, theme your booth to celebrate this special day!

You will also be asked to list a sampling of items that you have so we can place you in the proper area, as well as not having direct competition next to your space. Space rents will be \$30.00, and non-profits (supplying a Federal ID number) will be \$20.00 per space. Each space is the size of an average parking lot space.
